The Master of Arts in History requires the successful completion of the course in Historiography and Methodology (HIS 600) and fulfillment of one of two degree plans (please circle the plan chosen):

The Research Plan: A total of 30 semester hours—at least 24 of formal coursework, and 6 hours for the research, writing, and oral defense of an approved thesis. This plan requires 12 hours in a major geographic field plus 9 hours in one additional field (up to 6 hours in additional field may be from a cognate field). It must include at least one research seminar.

The Extended Coursework Plan: A total of 30 semester hours of formal coursework, including 12 hours in a major geographic field and two additional fields of 9-12 hours (one may be a cognate area). This plan must include one research seminar. The student takes a comprehensive final exam on the coursework.

Thesis title: _____

The student must select at least two areas of concentration. As few as 2 three hour courses may constitute an area. At the discretion of the committee, the student may be required to acquire a reading knowledge of a foreign language; such coursework is then considered an area of concentration. Coursework transferred from another institution should be shown on this form. A separate petition, filed with the Graduate College, must be approved for any transfer credit.
