\*\*Students must receive a grade of C or better in all MUP and MUS courses.

\*\*\* Language: You must demonstrate a two-semester proficiency in one of the following languages: French, German, and Italian. In addition, you must take one semester of each of the remaining two languages for a total of 16 credit hours.

You may meet this proficiency requirement in one of two ways:

1. By taking two semesters of college-level coursework in French, German, or Italian and one semester of each of the remaining two languages (eight [8] of the 16 credits may be applied to the Liberal Studies requirement);

**OR**

2. by taking CLEP exams, offered by the Counseling and Testing Center.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- This 8-term plan is to be used in conjunction with the academic catalog and degree audit report.
- Honors students complete different requirements to meet NAU's liberal studies program. Students should consult an Honors Program advisor for complete information on fulfilling Honors Liberal Studies requirements.

- Students must see an academic advisor before enrollment for the 7<sup>th</sup> term in preparation for graduation.
